Qualifying for assistance with your medical bills



Applications

Applications for financial assistance are available with the facility check-in staff, the Financial Counseling Department, and via the Business Office. The applications are available in English and Spanish.



CARTI will make a determination on your eligibility for financial assistance as soon as possible after receiving a completed application for assistance. You will receive written notice of the outcome of your case.

In the event your application is rejected, we will provide you with the reason for the rejection and provide you with information on how to appeal the determination. In the event you choose to appeal, we will work with you to ensure we take into account all relevant facts when making our final determination.

Are you uninsured or having problems paying your bills?

We may be able to help. If you are coping with a personal financial hardship due to lack of insurance or extraordinary medical costs, financial assistance may be available to cover some or all of the costs provided by CARTI.

Criteria

CARTI will provide you with financial assistance in the event that **all** of the following conditions are met:

- You have one or more outstanding balances due to CARTI.
- You have applied and been denied eligibility for any medical or health care coverage provided under Medicaid or State programs due to failure to satisfy income or other eligibility requirements.
- You are not eligible for coverage under any other health or accident insurance program.
- Your household income is at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines (Based on the annual Federal Poverty Guidelines).

Our trained Financial Counselors are available to assist you in determining whether you qualify for financial assistance. Our Financial Counselors can assist you with applying for financial assistance from government programs, and with establishing payment arrangements. They also can approve adjustments to your balance based on financial need and/or medical hardship.
